This is an appeal from an order transferring R.P., a juvenile, to adult court. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 707.) The parties have stipulated to reversal of the order, because Assembly Bill No. 2361 (2021-2022 Reg. Sess.) was enacted while this appeal was pending; it made certain ameliorative amendments to Welfare and Institutions Code section 707 that will go into effect on January 1, 2023; and R.P. is entitled to the benefit of these amendments.

We accept this stipulation. We find that there is no reasonable possibility that the interests of nonparties or the public will be adversely affected by the reversal, and the reasons of the parties for requesting reversal outweigh the erosion of public trust that may result from the nullification of a judgment and the risk that the availability of stipulated reversal will reduce the incentive for pretrial settlement. (Code Civ. Proc., § 128, subd. (a)(8).)

Accordingly, the order appealed from is reversed, and the trial court is directed to hold a new transfer hearing.
